

DRESS CODE

General Guidelines for everyone

Clothes should be reasonably loose fitting.

Tops must be long enough to cover the midriff.

Sleeves must be worn (outerwear with sleeves may be worn over sleeveless tops).

Necklines may not be lower than 4 fingers below the collarbone.

Clothing must not be sheer (opaque outerwear or innerwear may be worn with sheer clothing).

No underwear may show.

Logos and designs may not violate morality standards related to sex, alcohol, drugs, cigarettes, or immoral life styles including organizations that support such lifestyles.

Shorts must be long enough so that when standing the wearer's fingertips do not extend below the hem of the shorts.

Additional Guidelines for Females

Dress hemlines may not be higher than 2 inches above the knee.

Dresses may not have slits above the knee.

No tank tops, halter tops, or spaghetti straps.

Bare cleavage may not be visible.

Additional Guidelines for Males

Shirts must be worn.
